- 4. Principal's update(Joel Gorenkoff)

- Nov 7th is Take Our Kids to work day for Grade 9 students. Paperwork will be sent home for this soon.
- Nov 15th is report card day. Enclosed with the report card will be a code that is needed for parents to sign up online for parent teacher interviews.
- Nov 22nd is the day for Parent teacher Interviews. Teachers may call parents to set up a meeting if they feel it is necessary

6. Treasurer's Report and Financial Requests-Anne Ferguson

The cheque was deposited for the student fees and the 3 requests that were made from last month were paid which leaves a balance of 25,191.41

There are 5 requests for financial support from the Parent Council:

- 1. CPR for Grade 9 Girls (the Grade 9 boys will be next term) Total cost is \$3750 and they are asking for \$625.
- 2. Graffiti (School paper) is requesting assistance with the cost of publishing. Total cost is \$9000 and they are requesting \$1000
- 3. NT 12th annual Vocal Retreat is requesting \$1000 to help cover the cost of the retreat. Their total cost is \$26,000

- 4. The Classics Club is requesting \$600 to help out with this event held at Brock University. The total cost is \$3620.
- 5. NT has a Greenhouse and a request is made for \$680 to pay for plants and 2 light fixtures

All requests were motioned by Roland Herbert and seconded by Teodora Miloradovic and accepted by all.

7. Speaker Presentation- Jeffrey and Michael Eisen
